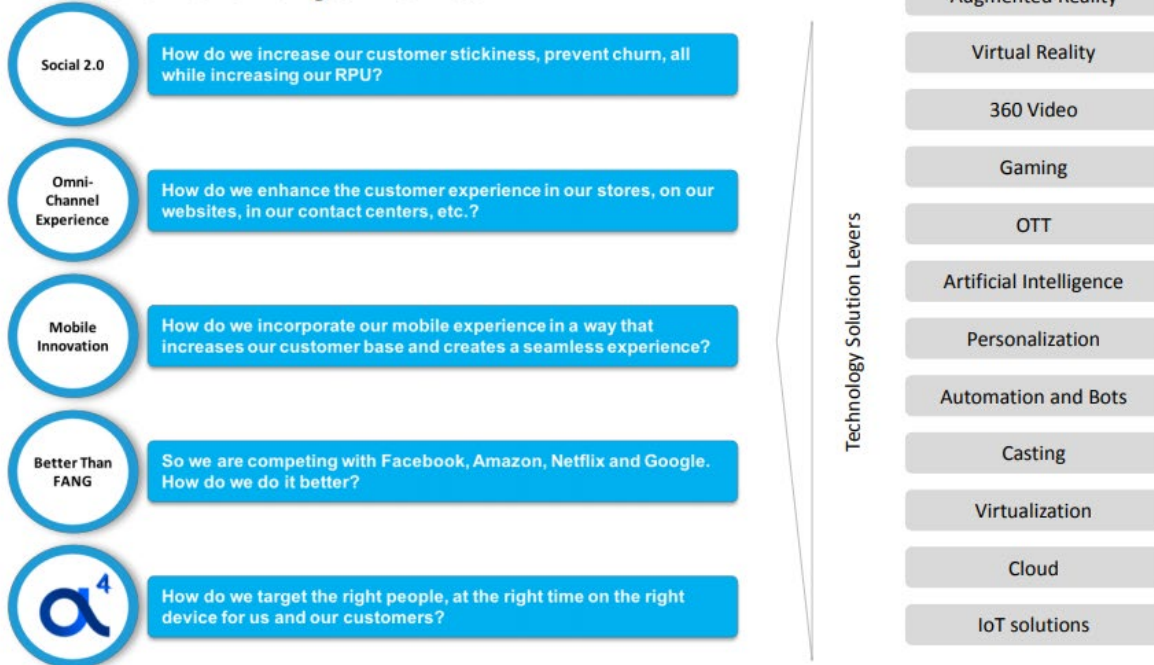


## 2018 University Hackathon:
